PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBIT: CHADWICK THROUGH THE LENSES OF CEDRIC WRIGHT AND ANSEL ADAMS

Never Before Seen Vintage Photos From Famed Photographers will be on Display at the Palos Verdes Library from January 7th – 21st

WHO: Chadwick School presents never before seen photographs by renown photographers...Ansel Adams, an American Photographer and Environmentalist, best known for his black and white photographs of Yosemite, and Cedric Wright, known for his photographs of the Sierra Club

WHAT: As part of Chadwick School's 75th anniversary, twenty-five copies of these never before seen photographs that Ansel Adams and Cedric Wright took of the campus, student life, sports and nature will be on display at the Palos Verdes Library.

The two photographers have had a long and special relationship with Chadwick beginning in the 1940s, when Ansel Adams set up the first dark room at Chadwick. At that time he began taking promotional photographs of Chadwick; some of which were included in the 1941 Chadwick Seaside School (original name of the school) catalogue. Ansel became so impressed with the school and its beautiful campus, he suggested that his friend Cedric Wright send his children there, and in 1948, Cedric Wright also began taking photographs at Chadwick to be used for promotional purposes by the school.
